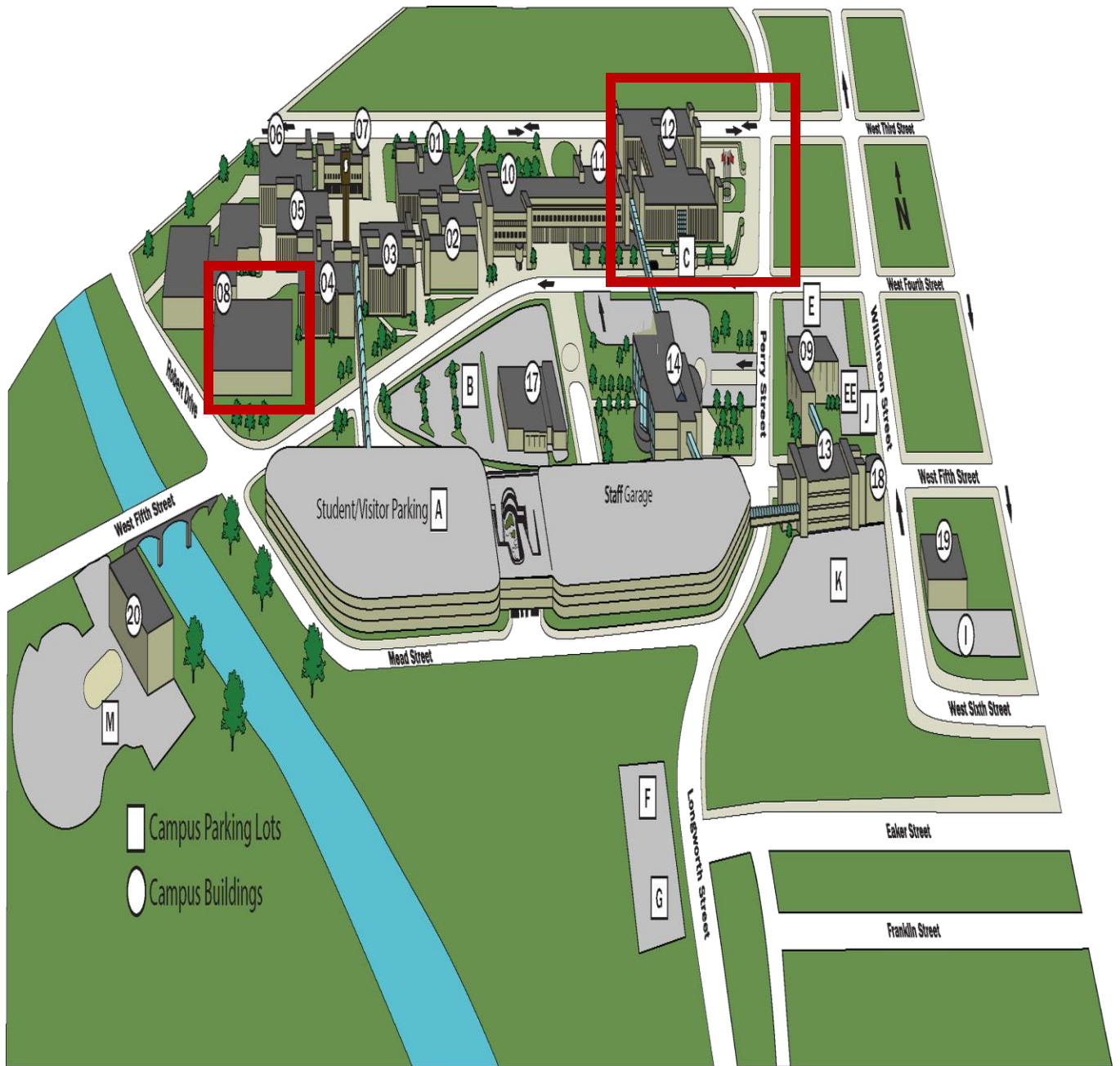

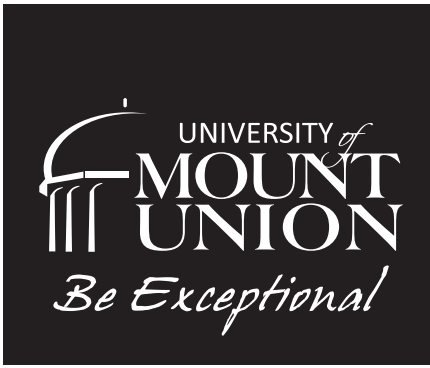

DIRECTIONS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MOUNT UNION

If you are searching for directions on your GPS, please use this address: 1972 Clark Ave., Alliance, Ohio 44601. Please note that this address will take you directly to Beeghly Hall, the institution's main administration building, as opposed to the Peterson Fieldhouse. You can view a map of the easiest route from Beeghly Hall to the Peterson Field House at www.mountunion.edu/Content/u/MAACParking-01-2192.pdf.

Specific routes from major Ohio metropolitan areas to Mount Union are as follows.

FROM CLEVELAND – Take I-77 south to Canton, then Rt. 62 east. Take the Alliance exit. Turn right. The University is approximately 2.5 miles down 62 (State Street). To reach the Peterson Field House, turn left onto Rockhill Avenue and then right onto Hartshorn Street. The field house will be on your right and the above-mentioned parking lot will be on the left.

FROM COLUMBUS – Take I-71 north to Mansfield, then Rt. 30 east to Canton. Follow I-77 north to Rt. 62 east. The University is approximately 2.5 miles down 62 (State Street). To reach the Peterson Field House, turn left onto Rockhill Avenue and then right onto Hartshorn Street. The field house will be on your right and the above-mentioned parking lot will be on the left.
