- The Steering Committee on Admission Practices has been meeting since early 2016 to review and update the SPGP.
- The committee solicited ideas and input from a broad cross section of members, including over 1,400 individuals, to reshape the document.
  - The new organization includes only mandatory statements, our core values, critical deadlines, practices, and a glossary of terms; and our steps for monitoring and applying penalties
  - The Preamble intentionally states that we are proud to include NACAC's commitment to providing access and support for the underrepresented and underserved and committed to addressing inequities in the college admission process
  - Sections have been added regarding truthfulness and transparency, professional conduct, and respect for confidentiality, along with sections covering application plans, deadlines, waitlists, and more
  - Sections on recruitment of transfer and international students have been added

- The last major revision was in 2007. The new SPGP will be voted on at this year's assembly.
  - Because the document has already been thoroughly and carefully prepared and reviewed by members, the leadership is recommending a suspension of the rules governing amendments so that the new SPGP can be presented without amendments, changes, or edits.
  - If either the motion to suspend the rules to allow comments but disallow amendments fails, OR the motion to adopt the new SPGP fails, the current SPGP will remain in force.
