Stefanie is a national leader in her field and a compelling spokesperson for the liberal arts, and she has been a successful, strategic, and innovative leader at multiple outstanding liberal arts institutions. Stefanie was appointed to the role of Vice President for Enrollment and Communications at Ohio Wesleyan University in August 2018.

During her more than 20-year enrollment career, Stefanie has served in leadership positions at Dickinson College, Hollins University, Bryn Athyn College, and DePauw University.

In 2008-09, Stefanie served as the president of the Indiana Association for College Admission Counseling, previously having been a member of board since 1998. She also had the opportunity to serve as a member of NACAC's National College Fair Committee and the Current Trends, Future Issues Committee. In September 2018, Stefanie assumed the presidency of the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC), the leading national organization for college admission counseling professionals. In 2017, Stefanie was the recipient of a Fulbright grant to examine the system of higher education in France. She has completed the Harvard Institute for Educational Management and the Educational Leadership Academy co-sponsored by the CIC and the AASCU. Stefanie has also been the chair of the Alumni Advisory Board of the Executive Doctoral Program of the Graduate School of Education at the University of Pennsylvania, and she is currently the vice president of the Board of Harrisburg Academy, a private, K-12 school in central Pennsylvania.

Stefanie holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from the University of Virginia, a Master of Science in education from Indiana University, and a Doctor of Education in Higher Education Management from the University of Pennsylvania.
