ARTICLE III

Membership

Reasons for change:

- 1) Change needed to mirror the changes to the NACAC bylaws and stay in compliance to no longer include language regarding the CEPP.
- 2) We do not have organizations or educational institutions based on membership categories; voting members can be employed by these entities but do not vote in a block format. Language needs to be omitted from bylaws to reflect the membership structure related to its voting members.
- 3) To be more inclusive of our active members in the voting process, language to has been added to include region representatives who reside in Ohio who work for a not-for-profit organization located out of state.
- 4) To clean up repetitive and unclear language and formatting

ARTICLE IV

Executive Board

Reasons for change:

- 1) Add Past President as co-chair of the Governance Committee
- 2) Most state affiliates have the delegate role overseeing a committee and serving as state affiliates to the NACAC Assembly. The NACAC Assembly is in flux, and the role of the delegate is not clear.
